The Pennsylvania Department of Aging (PDA) is issuing Aging Program Directive (APD) #24-01-04 "Area Agency on Aging (AAA) Program Requirements, Planning Allocations and Aging Services Block Grant Format for FY 2023-24 Revision #3". The APD is available for electronic access on the PDA website.

APD #24-01-04 includes an overall, approximate increase of \$13,840,223 above the Cooperative Agreement allocations. Highlighted changes include, but are not limited to:

- \$5,545,408 FAST / PS Line
- \$415,000 ARPA Dom Care
- \$5,760 Additional Senior Center Funds
